Pirate Dress Up Day – Thursday 18th July.

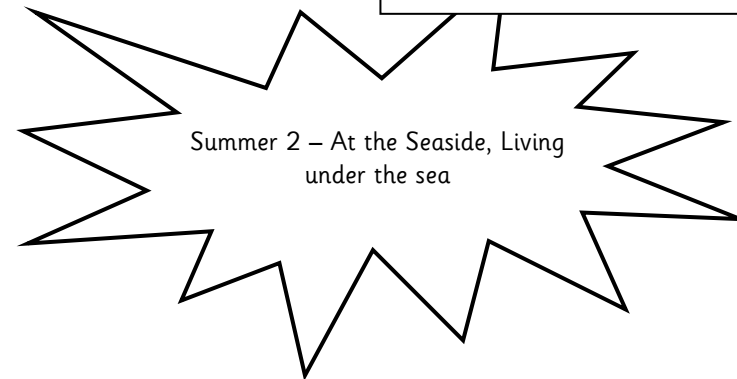
